Invitation for Bids (IFB)

1. The Government of Pakistan has received a credit from the International Development Association towards the cost of Sindh Resilience Project (Irrigation Component) and intends to apply part of the funds to cover eligible payments under the Contract for Work of **Providing Stone Apron from mile 1/6 to 2/1, repair to damaged Stone Pitching along S.H Bund mile 1/0 to 3/0 (Different Reaches) and widening & Strengthening of S.H Bund Mile 0/4 to 3/2**. Bidding is open to all bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and Grants by World Bank Borrowers* dated January 2011 (revised July 2014). (Procurement Guidelines).

2. The **Project Director Sindh Resilience Project (Irrigation Component)** invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the construction of **Stone Apron from mile 1/6 To 2/1, Repair to damaged Stone Pitching along S.H Bund mile 1/0 to 3/0, (Different Reaches) and widening & Strengthening of S.H Bund Mile 0/4 to 3/2 in Kalri Baghar Division Thatta (Baghar Circle Hyderabad)**, Contract No. PK-SID-2960-CW-SRP-NCB-01, the Works Comprises:

i) Earth Work ii) Stone Pitching

3. Bidding documents (and additional copies) may be purchased at **Office of the Project Director, Sindh Resilience Project (Irrigation Component), Bungalow No. 125-B, Main Khayaban-e-Bahria, Defence Phase-VII, Karachi** for a non-refundable fee of **Rs.5000/=** the method of payment will be in the form of demand draft or pay order in favour of **Project Director, Project management Team, Sindh Resilience Project (Irrigation Component)**. Interested bidders may obtain further information at the same address.

The works are to be completed in **364** days.

4. Bids shall be valid for a period of **90 days** after Bid opening and must be accompanied by bid security of 2% of the Bid Price and shall be delivered to **Office of the Project Director, Sindh Resilience Project (Irrigation Component) Bungalow No. 125-B, Main Khayaban-e-Bahria, Defence Phase-VII, Karachi** on or before August 07, 2017 at 1300 hours. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted, Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publically opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives, who choose to attend at the address mentioned above on August 07, 2017 at 1330 hours.

5. The Procurement process will be conducted in accordance with the **National Competitive Bidding (NCB) method** in accordance with paragraph 3.3 of "Guidelines Procurement of Goods, Works, and Non-Consulting Services Under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers (January 2011) (Revised 2014)".

6. A pre-bid meeting will be held at **1500 hours on July 27, 2017 at the office of the Project Director, Sindh Resilience Project (Irrigation Component), Bungalow No. 125-B, Main Khayaban-e-Bahria, Defence Phase-VII, Karachi**. The purpose of the meeting will be to clarify site and various other issues and to answer questions on any matter that may be raised at that stage. All potential Bidders that have obtained the Bidding Documents are invited to attend the meeting.

7. All bidders shall be required to submit with their bids, qualification information specified in the bidding documents. This information shall be used to establish through post-qualification whether the bidder is qualified to perform the work.

8. Bids are required to be submitted on item rate basis (not on the basis of Composite Schedule of Rates with percentage premium) and the rates and amount (in Rupees) must be filled by the bidder for each item in the Bill of Quantities and provide and total price. Non-compliance may result in rejection of bid.

9. Bidders should give their best and final price in their bids as no negotiations are expected.

10. As provided in the bidding documents, bidders engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices (including collusion/pooling) will be declared ineligible, either in indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a contract financed by the World Bank.
