- 3. The *Project Director Sindh Resilience Project* invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the Construction and Rehabilitation of Laboratory Buildings and Trays.
- 4. Bidding documents (and additional copies) may be purchased from the Office of the Project Director, Sindh Resilience Project (Irrigation Component), Bungalow No. 125-B, Khayaban-e-Bahria, Defence Housing Authority Phase-VII, Karachi for a nonrefundable fee of Rs. 2000/= for each set in the shape of the Pay Order/ Demand Draft in the favor of the Project Director SRP (PMT). Interested bidders may obtain further information at the same address.

The works are to be completed in 270 days.

- 5. Bids shall be valid for a period of 90 days after Bid opening and must be accompanied by security of 2% of the Bid Price and in the form of a Bank Guarantee and shall be delivered to Project Director, Sindh Resilience Project (Irrigation Component) Bungalow No. 125-B, Khayaban-e-Bahria, Defence Housing Authority Phase-VII, Karachi on or before August 09, 2019 at 11:00 hrs PST. The submitted bids will be opened on the same day at 11:00 hrs PST in the presence of Authorized Representative of the firms who wish to attend.
- 6. The Procurement process will be conducted in accordance with the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) method in accordance with paragraph 3.3 of "Guidelines Procurement Of Goods, Works, And Non-Consulting Services Under IBRD Loans And IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers (January 2011) (Revised 2014)".
- 7. A pre-bid conference will be held on July 25, 2019 at 12:00 hrs in the office of the Project Director, Sindh Resilience Project (Irrigation Component), Bungalow No. 125-B, Khayaban-e-Bahria, Defence Phase-VII, Karachi. The purpose of the meeting will be to clarify site and various other issues and to answer questions on any matter that may be raised at that stage. All potential Bidders who would have obtained the Bidding Documents are invited to attend.
- 8. All bidders shall be required to submit with their bids, qualification information specified in the bidding documents. This information shall be used to establish through post-qualification whether the bidder is qualified to perform the work.

- 9. Bids are required to be submitted on item rate basis (not on the basis of Composite Schedule of Rates with percentage premium) and the rates and amounts (in Rupees) must be filled by the bidder for each item in the Bill of Quantities and provide a total price. Non-compliance may result in rejection of bid.
- 10. Bidders should give their best and final price in their bids as no negotiations are expected.
- 11. As provided in the bidding document, bidders engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices (including collusion/pooling) will be declared ineligible, either in indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a contract financed by the World Bank.
