1. The **Government of Pakistan** has received credit from the International Development Association towards the cost of Sindh Resilience Project (Irrigation Component) and intends to apply part of the funds to cover eligible payments under the Contract for Works of **Reconstruction of Soil Mechanics Laboratory and Office Building at Karachi.**
2. Bidding is open to all bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and Grants by World Bank Borrowers" dated January 2011 (revised July 2014). (Procurement Guidelines)
3. The **Project Director Sindh Resilience Project** invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the **Reconstruction of Soil Mechanics Laboratory and Office Building at Karachi.**
4. Bidding documents (and additional copies) may be purchased from the Office of the Project Director, Sindh Resilience Project (Irrigation Component), Bungalow No. 125-B, Khayaban-e-Bahria, Defence Housing Authority Phase-VII, Karachi for a nonrefundable fee of Rs. 2000/= for each set in the shape of the Pay Order/ Demand Draft in the favor of the Project Director – SRP (PMT). Interested bidders may obtain further information at the same address.

The works are to be completed in 270 days.

5. Bids shall be valid for a period of **90 days** after Bid opening as mentioned in the bidding documents and must be accompanied by bid security of minimum **2%** of the Bid Price in the form of a Bank Guarantee and shall be delivered to **Project Director, Sindh Resilience Project (Irrigation Component) Bungalow No. 125-B, Khayaban-e-Bahria, Defence Housing Authority Phase-VII, Karachi** on or before **August 19, 2020 at 12:30 hrs PST.** The submitted bids will be opened on the same day at **12:30 hrs PST** in the presence of Authorized Representatives of the firms who wish to attend. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected
6. The Procurement process will be conducted in accordance with the **National Competitive Bidding (NCB) method** in accordance with paragraph 3.3 of "Guidelines Procurement Of Goods, Works, And Non-Consulting Services Under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers (January 2011) (Revised 2014)".
7. Due to prevailing Covid-19 situation, pre-bid conference will not be held; any questions/ queries may be delivered to the address given below in writing at least 10 days before the deadlines for submission of bids.

8. All bidders shall be required to submit with their bids, qualification information specified in the bidding documents. This information shall be used to establish through post-qualification whether the bidder is qualified to perform the work.
9. Bids are required to be submitted on item rate basis (not on the basis of Composite Schedule of Rates with percentage premium) and the rates and amounts (in Rupees) must be filled by the bidder for each item in the Bill of Quantities and provide a total price. Non-compliance may result in rejection of bid.
10. Bidders should give their best and final price in their bids as no negotiations are expected.
11. As provided in the bidding document, bidders engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices (including collusion/pooling) will be declared ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a contract financed by the World Bank.
