The Project Director Sindh Resilience Project (Irrigation Component) invited the sealed quotations from reputed Contractors/firms for below mentioned Civil Work through Shopping Method of World Bank Regulations. The Request for Quotation offer and accompanying documents must be received to the office of the Project Director Sindh Resilience Project (Irrigation Component) address Bungalow No: 125-B, Main Khayaban-e-Bahria Defence Housing Authority, Phase-VII Karachi, on June 15th, 2022 upto 11.00 PST. The received quotations will be opened in the presence of Procurement Committee/Participating Contractors/firms and their authorized representatives.

In case of any member of Procurement Committee happens to be out of Headquarter or in case any lockdown by the Government, the date of opening of quotations will be submitted and opened on next working day on same schedule.

At least 03 works of same specifications and nature of equivalent or more completed during past three years, duly supported with completion certificates. The detail of assignment is attached (Annexure-A).

Valid Registration Certificates upto-date and onwards with Pakistan Engineering Council in relevant category and specialized codes as below mentioned work.

The Quotations determined to be substantially responsive to this Request for Quotation will be evaluated by comparison of their offer prices. A quotation is not substantially responsive if it contains material deviations or reservations to the terms, conditions, and specifications in this Request for Quotation.

Terms and Conditions:-

- 1) The received quotations will be evaluated through Shopping Method of procurement in accordance with the World Bank's procedure set out in the "World Bank Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers (July 2016) revised November 2017 & August 2018 ("Procurement Regulations").

- 2) The Quotations must be submitted according to the attached Detail of Work (Annexure-A).
- 3) The Taxes will be deducted according to the Government Rules.
- 4) Registration with Income Tax Department (NTN Certificates) with activate status Federal Board of Revenue.
- 5) Registration Certificates of Sindh Revenue Board Government of Sindh with activate status (SRB) certificates.
- 6) The Contractors/firms have to quote their offer with including all taxes.
- 7) The Contractors/firms shall submit only one set of quotations. The quotation must be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by authorized representative. Without a signature, quotation will not be considered.
- 8) The firms are requested to quote the offer in Pak rupees.
- 9) The firms are requested to give their best and final prices as such no negotiations are expected.
- 10) The payment will be made within 14 days, after receipt of invoice.
- 11) Joint Venture will not be entertained.
- 12) Affidavit to the effect that the firms/contractors have not been blacklisted previously by any executing agency.
- 13) The quotations should be submitted along with the above require documentation/information, if such lacks the quotations will not be considered by the Procurement Committee and no excuse will be considered.
- 14) The quotation(s) should be valid for a period of 30 days from the deadline for submission of the quotation/(s) as indicated above. If the firm withdraw their quotation during the validity period and/or refuse to accept the award of a contract when and if awarded, then Contractor/firm will be excluded from the list of the project for two years.
